January full moon.

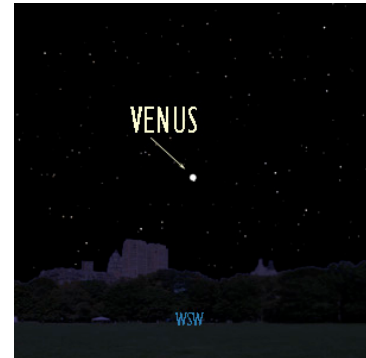

Early risers can check out the last quarter moon on the morning of the 18th!

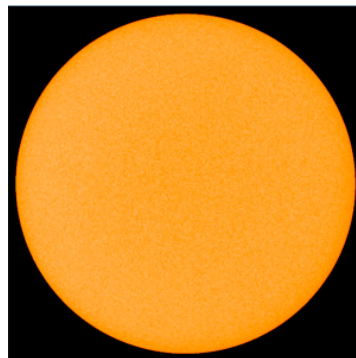
