FUN FACT: THANKSGIVING IN SPACE

Turkey? Check. Mashed potatoes? Check. Candied yams, cornbread stuffing and green beans? Check!

How exactly does an astronaut prepare a holiday meal in space? They simply add hot or cold water to the pouches of dried food before eating. The other foods are heated up in the food galley's oven, basically a hot plate which uses a fan to circulate heated air.

Each food pouch has a Velcro tag that can be affixed to the astronauts' suit or food tray to keep from floating around.
