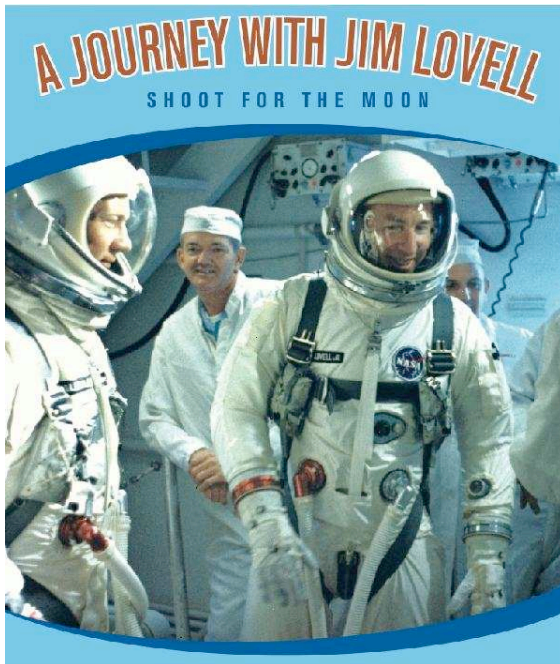

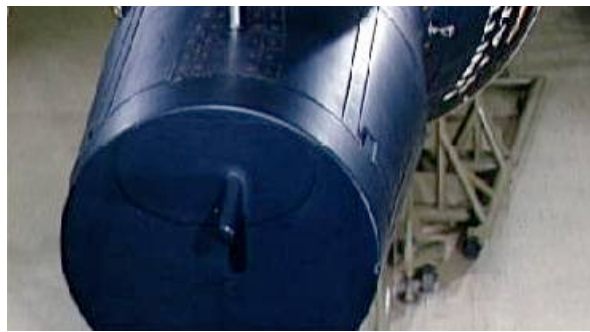

Astronauts Jim Lovell and Buzz Aldrin not only have "the right stuff," they have a great sense of humor, too! On November 11, 1966, as Lovell and Aldrin boarded the Gemini 12 spacecraft, spectators got the not-so-subtle message that this mission was to be the last of the Gemini program.

Pictured left to right, Lovell and Aldrin wore signs "The" and "End" on the back of their spacesuits. While that may have been the
